## Standardised Price List

All Funeral Directors are legally required to publish this Price List for a standardised set of products and services. This is to help you think through your options and make choices, and to let you compare prices between different funeral directors because prices vary.

	<b>CMF</b>
<b>Attended Funeral (funeral director's charge only)</b>	<b>£ 1,900</b>
This is a funeral where family and friends have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person at the same time as they attend their burial or cremation. This is a "traditional" funeral.	
This comprises of:	
Taking care of all necessary legal and administrative arrangements	£ 575
Collecting and transporting the deceased into our care (usually within 20 miles of our premises)	£ 215
Care and preparation of the deceased prior to the funeral. The deceased will be kept at our premises.	£ 445
Providing a suitable coffin - this is made from oak wood-effect veneer.	£ 315
Viewing of the deceased by family and friends by appointment.	£ -
At a date and time you agree with the funeral director, taking the deceased to the agreed cemetery of crematorium (usually within 20 miles of our premises) in our traditional hearse.	£ 350
<b>Unattended Funeral</b>	
This is a funeral where family and friends may choose to have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person, but they do not attend the burial or cremation itself.	
<b>Burial (funeral director's charges only)</b>	<b>£ 995</b>
<b>Cremation (funeral director's charge plus the cremation fee)*</b>	<b>£ 1,495</b>
<b>Other fees you must pay (Disbursements)</b>	
For an Attended or Unattended Burial Funeral, the burial fee. In this local area, the typical cost of the burial fee for local residents is:	£735 to £1,046
For a new grave, you will also need to pay for the plot; for an existing grave with a memorial in place, you may need to pay a removal and or replacement fee. In addition, the cemetery may charge a number of other fees.	
For an Attended Cremation Funeral, the cremation fee. In this local area, the typical cost of a cremation for local residents is:	£800 to £1,100

<b>Additional Funeral Director Products &amp; Services</b>	
We may be able to supply a range of optional, additional products and services or to arrange (on your behalf) for a third party to supply them. Examples include:	
Additional Mileage (per mile)	£ 2
Additional transfers of the deceased ie to their home or place of worship (per transfer)	£ 215
Collection and delivery of ashes	FOC
Embalming (if not part of a funeral)	£ 195
Funeral Officiant eg Celebrant, Minister of Faith etc (approx)	£ 200
Services supplied outside of normal office hours	POA
*The date and place of cremation will be chosen by the funeral director. In addition a Doctors fee is payable for signing the Medical Certificate. The total cost of the funeral must be paid before the funeral takes place.	
** The burial fee, which is sometimes referred to as the interment fee, is the charge made by the cemetery.
